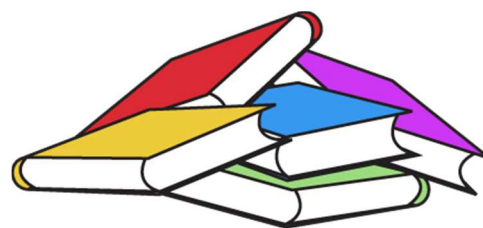
Young Carers Awareness day
