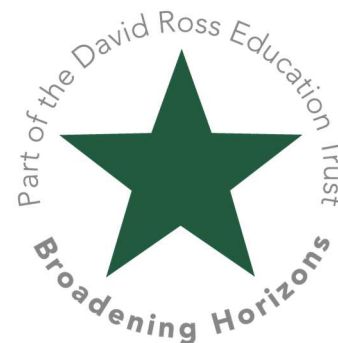

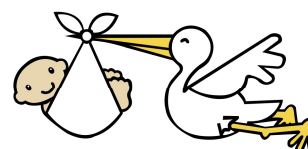
## ParentPay.com
